Terms of Use

1. What the App Does

- The **stay•safe® CAPD - VR Demo USA** app provides supplemental patient training related to a patient's at-home administration of peritoneal dialysis using Fresenius Medical Care medical devices and drug products.
- This app is meant to help patients prescribed home peritoneal dialysis understand general concepts and practice skills in a virtual environment.
- The app gives information, but it is not medical advice.
- This app does not replace in-person training required by a patient's dialysis program and/or health care provider before starting home peritoneal dialysis therapy.
- This app is intended for educational purposes only.
- You need compatible hardware, software, and internet access to use the app.

2. Signing Up

- You must buy and download the app from the Meta App Store.
- Fresenius Medical Care may ask for more information or block your account if you break the rules.

3. Who Owns the Content

- Everything in the app—pictures, videos, text, logos, and more—belongs to Fresenius Medical Care or its partners.
- You cannot copy, share, or change the content.
- You get a limited personal license to use the app.
- You do not own any part of the app or its content.

4. Ending Your Access

- You can stop your subscription anytime through the Meta App Store.
- If you delete your Meta account or device, you lose access to the app.
- Fresenius Medical Care can change or stop the app at any time.

- Fresenius Medical Care can remove your account if you break the rules, such as:
 - Using the app for anything other than learning
 - Sharing viruses or harming the app
 - Using bots or scraping content
 - Collecting other users' information
 - Trying to get around security tools

5. Limits to Fresenius Medical Care's Responsibility

- You use the app at your own risk.
- The app is provided "as is," meaning Fresenius Medical Care does not promise it will always work perfectly.
- Fresenius Medical Care is not responsible for problems caused by things like power outages, internet issues, software or hardware failures, or any other reason outside of Fresenius Medical Care's reasonable control.
- You must not use the same Meta account on multiple headsets.

6. Privacy

- Meta collects and controls the data you give when you create your Meta account and use your Meta device.
- Fresenius Medical Care only receives your Meta Account ID and subscription status.
