

## 2023 Sustainability Highlights

Key highlights in our strategic focus areas for sustainability



Enhancing quality of care and access to healthcare

- In about 4,000 dialysis clinics we provide care for over 332,000 patients.
- Patient satisfaction is measured by an excellent patient Net
  Promoter Score of 72, and 78% of our patients would highly recommend our services.
- 42% more patients were referred to kidney transplantation clinics through our new Referral Ready IT platform in the U.S.
- In more than 170 published scientific research documents we shared our insights.

Building the best team to serve patients

- The share of women in the top two management levels below the Management Board increased to 34%.
- Our employees received over **38 hours** of training on average.
- We trained around 95% of our employees on our Code of Ethics and Business Conduct and 97% on data protection.
- More than 50% of our internal audits included topics related to respecting human rights.
- More than 1,600 employees were supported with nearly
  €1.7 million in grants through our FME CARES Fund.



- Our Scope 1 and 2 CO<sub>2</sub> emissions decreased by 16% from a 2020 baseline.
- We submitted our commitment letter to the Science Based Targets initiative and have officially committed to the initiative's goals.
- We reduced our water withdrawal by 4% compared with 2022.
- 100 environmental projects were implemented at our production sites to save water and energy, prevent emissions, and recycle or reuse waste.
